- TEDD/Billings Bypass - Steve Arveschoug, BSED
  - 3 priorities of BSED: Support Business, Recruit New Business, Community Development
  - Phase I: What is the resolution or necessity?
  - Phase II: Outline how to develop
  - Billings Bypass - Can add pedestrian solutions without opening the ROD (record of decision)
    - Could be included as part of TIFF/TEDD funds
    - TIGER Grant, plus other grants to bring in money for infrastructure
  - Billings City Council - Ward 2
    - Joe will get in contact with Dennis Pitman or Angela Cimmino to gain support of Bypass pedestrian issue.
  - Kathy Aragon has written a letter to the MDT for the Bike Walk Montana Board to consider regarding the Bypass pedestrian issue.
    - LPSD advisory board supports letter
- Riverstone Health's Healthy by Design coalition - Melissa Henderson
  - Update to Complete Streets Policy to City Council 4/6/15. Policy adopted 2011.
  - Advise to use the following terms in lieu of Complete Streets:
    - Safe/Inclusive/ADA Compliance
    - "Connecting" to destinations
    - Health Impact Assessment
- Bike Education Workshop: Traffic Skills 101 (TS101) - April 18-19, Saturday 9am-5pm with lunch break, Sunday 2pm with no lunch break, or 3pm with lunch break
  - Fast paced class that will give the confidence to ride safely and legally in traffic or on the trail. Bicycle safety checks, on-bike skills and crash avoidance techniques. Classroom instruction, on-bike drills, ride in and around traffic to practice learned skills.
  - All participants must have working bike and helmet
  - Ages 14+, 12-15 people, \$600
  - Rieck will handle media for event
  - Talmark motioned to approve TS101 Workshop, Woods seconded. Woods made motion to approve \$600 fee to Instructors Melinda Barnes & Taylor Lonsdale, Porter seconded.
- CDBG Grant available. Make sure we are checking in to coordinate with BSED and BTRC&D for grant opportunities.
- Update on HWY 87 E pathway from Peters Street to Old Hardin Road (3Gs) from Chuck Strum
  - Canal Route options are possible with Lockwood Irrigation District for recreational trail
  - Culvert will need bridge or ask Standishes if a right of way may be on their property to go around.
  - Culvert issue at HWY 87 E and Old Hardin Road intersection, on Bealle property
  - Loan and grant update from Eskine
- LPSD Bylaws need to be created.
