RESCINDING STAGE I FIRE RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Yellowstone County passed Resolution 18-76 on August 7, 2018 enacting a burning ban and Stage I fire restrictions; and

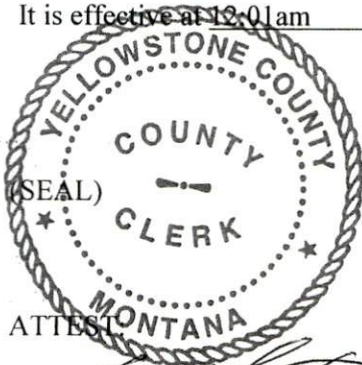
WHEREAS, conditions have changed in Yellowstone County with cooler temperatures and much needed rainfall reducing the fire hazard; and

WHEREAS, citizens may need to burn before the winter season.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 2) Citizens, Farmers and Ranchers can commence burning with an approved burning permit issued by the On-line Burn Permitting system administered by the County Fire Warden's office and following the procedures on the permit.

It is effective at 12:01am on the 7 th day of September 2018.




