

Yellowstone County Emergency Declaration
Resolution No. 10-54

WHEREAS, a severe summer storm with multiple tornadoes, on June 20, 2010 has caused extensive damage to the METRA Park arena, other building and fairgrounds as well as other minor damage within Yellowstone County and;

WHEREAS, the storm damage has required the activation of the City/County Emergency Operations Center and coordinated the various County resources including law enforcement, public works, etc. to be called into action at substantial costs to the County and;

WHEREAS, the City/County EOC activated the Montana National Guard through MTDES for security and law enforcement assistance for damaged business and commercial property;


WHEREAS, the County of Yellowstone does recognize the potential economic and financial impact to county residents as a result of the extraordinary costs of support services and repair of the damages as a result of this massive storm;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED pursuant to Title 10, Chapter 3, Part 4, MCA, by the Yellowstone County Commission that an emergency for Yellowstone County is hereby declared, the City/County Emergency Operations Plan will be in effect for the duration of this event, and we request the Governor of the State of Montana declare an emergency/disaster to assist Yellowstone County with resources as needed and financial assistance;




