

**Yellowstone County DUI Task Force Meeting Minutes**

City Cab presented an update on the Tavern Taxi enhancement program. To date, six bars have chosen to participate in this 2-for-1 ticket offer—Lee's, Tap Inn, The Squire Lounge, FOE 30, Powderhorn, and Andy's. City Cab has been working hard to get the word out on this offer. The Tavern Association has not provided a directory or membership list to City Cab even though the request has been made. Laura can provide Rod a list of all establishments in the county with a liquor license and Rod will filter through those contacts to help promote this program.

Darla asked for help with ideas and/or speakers for future Community 7 shows. MHP can help in October with the topic of winter driving; the Willsons, Monte Wallis and Kristin also offered to serve as guests. A suggestion was made to have Community 7 videotape a re-enactment of a person going through the DUI Processing Center.

We will add a page to our website highlighting different projects the Task Force is currently conducting or participating in, such as photos from the March Against Drugs and Violence, Angel Tree Ceremony, projects supported by the RFP process, etc.

The Booth schedule for MT Fair 2009 was made available for people to sign. An updated version will be emailed shortly. In addition to the product giveaway at the booth, a motion was made to purchase eight \$25.00 gift cards which will be given out through a random drawing once/day. Motion seconded and carried. Darla will purchase a variety of gift cards totaling \$200. We will have a paper slips for registering for the prizes and a box at the booth. The drawing will occur nightly at 10:00 PM and winner's name will be posted at the booth. Gift card will be mailed to the winner. Rules will posted as: 1 drawing daily; 1 winner per day; no purchase necessary; contact info will not be used or sold for soliciting purposes.
