The resolution is contingent on the approval of the voters. The increase would be perpetual. 1.73 mills currently would raise an additional \$578,335.00 (approximate). If the mill levy increase passes, the property taxes on a \$100,000.00 home would increase by approximately \$2.33 per year. If the mill levy increase passes, the property taxes on a \$200,000.00 home would increase by approximately \$4.67 per year.
