

RURAL SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 382

Resolution Creating District.

The following resolution, introduced by Commissioner Platb  
who moved its adoption, was seconded by Commissioner Barney, and  
was unanimously passed and adopted:

"WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Yellowstone  
County, Montana, being in regular session and having this day  
received a petition for the creation of a rural special improvement  
district for the purpose of installing certain water mains in  
a portion of the Hamilton Subdivision, and grading certain streets  
therein; and

WHEREAS, said petition is signed by 100% of the freeholder  
affected thereby, which freeholders have filed herein their  
written waiver to the adoption and passing of a resolution of  
intention to create said improvement district, and of the giving  
of notice thereof by posting, publishing, mailing, or otherwise,  
and consented that the Board of County Commissioners may  
immediately pass and adopt a resolution creating the improvement  
district proposed by their petition; and it appearing there are  
no other freeholders affected by said proposed district; and

WHEREAS, it appears the proposed special improvement  
district is in a thickly populated locality outside the limits of  
an incorporated town or city, and adjacent to the city limits of  
the City of Billings, Montana, and that the public interest and  
convenience require that such district be created and the  
proposed improvements made and installed, and that the said City  
of Billings has approved the proposed extension of water mains  
to serve said district, from their public water supply system;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of  
County Commissioners of Yellowstone County, Montana:

1           1. That the Board of County Commissioners have acquired  
2 jurisdiction to order and create the proposed district, and that  
3 there is hereby created a rural special improvement district to  
4 be numbered and described as Rural Special Improvement District  
5 No. 382, in Yellowstone County, Montana; that the general  
6 character of the improvements to be made are to install a six-inch  
7 cast iron water main in Phillip Street, and in Stone Street,  
8 from Riverside Road to Millard Street, together with all  
9 necessary hydrants, valves and fittings, and also for the purpose  
10 of gravelling and grading Phillip and Stone Streets, from  
11 Riverside Road to Millard Street.

12           2. That the approximate estimated cost of such improve-  
13 ments is the sum of \$7,420.00, or approximately \$229.02 per lot.


14           3. That the name of the engineer who shall have charge  
15 of such improvements is L. R. SAMPSON, of Billings, Montana.

16           4. That the boundaries of said district shall include  
17 all of Lots 1 to 6, both inclusive, in Block 6; all of Lots 1 to  
18 16, both inclusive, in Block 4; and all of Lots 1 to 10, inclusive  
19 in Block 2, all of the HAMILTON SUBDIVISION, Yellowstone County,  
20 Montana, according to the official plat thereof, on file and of  
21 record in the office of the clerk and recorder of said county.

22           5. That payment for the work and labor and materials to  
23 be furnished and installed in making said improvements shall be  
24 met by the execution and delivery of coupon bonds drawn against  
25 the funds of said district, and by the levying and assessing of  
26 a tax upon the properties in the district, payments of which  
27 shall be spread over a period of ten years."
