

Resolution No. 15-110  
Resolution to Dissolve Rural Special Improvement District (RSID) No. 800M

WHEREAS, a board of county commissioners has the authority to create and dissolve rural special improvement districts for the construction and maintenance of public improvements. See Sections 7-12-2010 through 7-12-2198 of the Montana Code Annotated.

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2011, the Yellowstone County Board of County Commissioners created Rural Special Improvement District No. 800M to maintain the paved roads in Antelope Hills Subdivision. Upon review by the County, it was discovered that rather than creating a new RSID, the properties within the boundaries of RSID #800M should have been, and now have been, absorbed into RSID #717M, the Oxbow Subdivision. Therefore, RSID #800M is superfluous and it is in the best interests of the public to dissolve it.


WHEREAS, the Yellowstone County Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing as to whether to dissolve RSID No. 800M at 9:30 a.m. in room 403A of the Yellowstone County Courthouse in Billings, Montana. The Board took testimony from the public and considered any written comments regarding dissolution of the RSID. No protests were lodged with the Board. Following the hearing, the Board determined that it was in the best interests of the public to dissolve the RSID.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that RSID #800M is hereby dissolved.


